Each student will need to provide the material listed below for the upcoming school year. Personal supplies should be replenished at the beginning of every term or as needed. Please ensure that *everything* is labeled with your child's name.

- o 1 Laptop (grades 4 6) w/ Microsoft Office
- 1 jump drive 4GB (Grades 3-6)
- Backpack/Book Bag
- 1 P.E. Bag (should be waterproof for swim gear)
- Lunch Box
- Pencil Case/box (only one please)
- o #2 lead pencils package of 24 or more
- o Color pencils
- 1 pack of 12 broad tip markers (grades 1-3 only)
- 1 pack of fine tip markers (grades 4-6 only)
- Sharpener (no electric sharpeners)
- o 2 highlighters
- o Box of crayons, 24 or fewer
- 1 hand sanitizer (no larger than 12 oz)

- 1 American dictionary/thesaurus (Grades 2-6) (Merriam-Webster or Scholastic)- Students in grades 5 & 6 must use an adult dictionary

- Pair of quality pointed scissors (Fiskar-type recommended)
- Colored pen or pencil for correcting (grade 3 and up)
- o 6" ruler
- 3 Duo-tang twin pocket portfolios (any color)
- Small box of Kleenex (will be pooled for students to use throughout year)
- 1 old T-shirt to be used as a "paint shirt" or art apron

- o 2" Binder x 4 (grades 3 & up)
