

## SCHOOL UNIFORM 2018/2019 (K2-Grade 6)

All items with the exception of the uniform polo shirt and P.E. kits may be purchased from Sandy's.  
Please note that all students come dressed to school in their P.E. kits twice weekly.

### GIRLS- Regular School Uniform

- Light yellow polo shirt with school logo (available at the school)
- Khaki skorts/scooters (Preschool-Grade 6)
- Khaki pleated skirts (Grades 3-6 only)- girls in grade 3 have the option of a skirt or skort/scooter
- Plain **light** yellow socks (no mustard colored socks please)
- Plain **low-heeled/flat dark brown** (not tan) shoes (no patent leather please)
- Dark brown school sweater with logo (ordered through school)
- Light yellow, white, dark brown or khaki hair accessories may be worn with regular school uniform
- School bucket hat with logo to wear outside-optional (ordered through school)
- Dark brown blazer with school's logo (ordered through school) OPTIONAL
- Dark brown sweater with or without school's logo – Sweaters should be free of any large logos
- School logo shirt (ordered through the school)

### GIRLS- Physical Education Uniforms

- Physical education shorts (in sports house color) with school's logo (ordered through the school)
- P.E. shirt with school's logo (ordered through school)
- Red sweatsuit w/ school's logo (optional- may be worn over P.E. Kit year-round) (ordered through school)
- Plain red or black One-Piece Swimsuit (K3 through Grade 6) – red preferably
- Swimming Cap
- Swim towel
- Swim goggles
- A black, white or red rash guard is highly recommended for students who swim
- Plain white socks for P.E. (no ankle socks allowed-socks must be visible when worn)
- Only white, white/red, white/navy, white/silver or white/black low-top sneakers may be worn (Sneakers should have Velcro closure until student knows how to tie his/her shoes). *Please ensure that sneakers are predominantly white and without characters, lights, etc.*
- Complementary hair accessories may be worn on P.E. days
- School bucket hat to wear outside (ordered through school)

### BOYS- Regular School Uniform

Light yellow polo shirt with updated school logo (available at the school)

- Khaki shorts (Preschool-Grade 3) – elasticized waist bands are preferred for students in K2 and K3
- Khaki long pants (grades 4 and higher)
- Dark brown school sweater or blazer with logo (ordered through school)
- Khaki socks
- Dark brown shoes (no boots, sneakers or high-tops allowed)



- School bucket hat to wear outside (ordered through school)
- A dark brown belt may be worn IF the student is able to operate the belt without a teacher's assistance

#### **BOYS- Physical Education Uniforms**

- Physical education shorts with school's logo (ordered through school)
- Physical education shirt (ordered through school)
- Red sweatsuit w/ school's logo (optional- may be worn over P.E. Kit year-round) (ordered through school)
- Plain red or black Swimming Trunks or Swim shorts (K3 through Grade 6)
- Swim goggles
- Swim towel
- A black, white or red rash guard is highly recommended
- Plain white socks for P.E. (no ankle socks allowed-socks must be visible when worn)
- Predominantly white, low-top sneakers (shoes may have simple stripes, logo, etc). Please note that shoes should be free of characters, lights, etc.
- House Shirt (ordered through school)
- School bucket hat to wear outside (ordered through school)

#### **WINTER SCHOOL UNIFORM - Optional**

- Long sleeved polo shirts with school logo (available at the school)
- White turtleneck shirts may be worn under school polo shirt if so desired
- Long Pants (boys and girls)
- Girls may wear white tights under skirts if desired on cool days

#### **WINTER P.E. UNIFORM – Optional (may be interchanged with the tracksuit during cooler months)**

- Red sweatpants and sweatshirts w/ the school's logo may be worn on cool P.E. days. (ordered through the school). Please ensure that the correct socks and tennis shoes are worn.

#### **JEWELRY**

- All students are allowed to wear a wristwatch. Only girls are allowed to wear one pair of simple gold, stud or sleeper earrings. Both males and females may wear one simple gold or silver chain. Please note that the school will not be held responsible for any lost jewelry. Any student wearing inappropriate jewelry will have it confiscated by the classroom teacher and parents will have to come and collect it from the school's office.

#### **HAIR STYLES**

- Summit expects that all of its students will have neatly groomed hair. Students are not allowed to wear hair beads to school. All boys *must* have neatly groomed hairstyles. Boys with longer hair should be kept above the top of the shirt collar. For boys, cornrows (beyond K2) and mohawks (all grades) are not permitted. No student is allowed to have dyed hair.

**Students who do not follow the uniform code will receive a uniform violation letter.**

**Please ensure that all clothing is clearly labeled, including shoes.**
