Each student will need to provide the material listed below for the upcoming school year. Personal supplies should be replenished at the beginning of every term or as needed. Please ensure that *everything* is labeled with your child's name.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 1 Laptop (grades 4 - 8) w/ Microsoft Office</li> <li>○ Backpack/Book Bag (bag should be able to fit in locker)</li> <li>○ 1 P.E. Bag (should be waterproof for swim gear)</li> <li>○ Lunch Box</li> <li>○ Pencil Case/box (only one please)</li> <li>○ #2 lead pencils – package of 24 or more</li> <li>○ Color pencils</li> <li>○ 1 pack of 12 broad tip markers (grades 1-3 only)</li> <li>○ 1 pack of fine tip markers (grades 5-7 only)</li> <li>○ Sharpener (no electric sharpeners)</li> <li>○ 2 highlighters</li> <li>○ Box of crayons, 24 or fewer</li> <li>○ 1 hand sanitizer (no larger than 12 oz)</li> <li>○ Clear contact paper to cover books</li> <li>○ 1 American dictionary/thesaurus (Grades 2-7) (Merriam-Webster or Scholastic)- Students in grades 5 - 8 must use an adult dictionary</li> <li>○ 1 pair of quality over the head headphones- may be kept in personal locker when not in use.</li> <li>○ 1 Soprano Recorder (grades 2 &amp; 3)</li> <li>○ B-flat Clarinet, B-flat trumpet, B-flat saxophone, E-Flat Alto Saxophone, B-flat flute, B-flat trombone or soprano recorder (grades 4-8)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Glue Sticks (at least six)</li> <li>○ Elmer's school liquid glue</li> <li>○ Pair of quality pointed scissors (Fiskar-type recommended for students in grades 1-4)</li> <li>○ Colored pen or pencil for correcting (grade 3 and up)</li> <li>○ 6" ruler</li> <li>○ 3 Duo-tang twin pocket portfolios (any color)</li> <li>○ Small box of Kleenex (will be pooled for students to use throughout year)</li> <li>○ 1 old T-shirt to be used as a "paint shirt" or art apron</li> <li>○ 1 pack of blue ink pens (grades 5-7 only)</li> <li>○ 2" Binder x 2 (grades 3 &amp; up) –Grades 7/8 require three 2" binders</li> <li>○ Index dividers for each binder (grades 3 &amp; up)</li> <li>○ Geometry Set (Grades 7 &amp; 8 only)</li> <li>○ Name labels and/or permanent marker to label all belongings (ex. <a href="http://www.namebubbles.com">www.namebubbles.com</a>, <a href="http://www.stuckonyou.com">www.stuckonyou.com</a>, <a href="http://www.itsminelabels.com">www.itsminelabels.com</a>)</li> <li>○ 3-4 packs of blue pens (please only send one pack on the first day of school)</li> <li>○ 1 pack of colored pens (grades 5-7)</li> </ul>
