



GENERAL SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

GRADES 1- 8

Each student will need the materials listed below for the upcoming school year. Personal supplies should be replenished at the beginning of every term or as needed. Please ensure that *everything* is labeled with your child's name.

- Backpack/Book Bag (bag should be able to fit in locker)
- 1 P.E. Bag (should be waterproof for swim gear)
- Lunch Box
- Pencil Case/box (only one please)
- #2 lead pencils – package of 24 or more
- 1 pack of blue ink pens (grades 5-8 only)
- Colored pen or pencil for correcting (grade 3 and up)
- 12" ruler
- Color pencils
- 1 pack of markers
- Sharpener (no electric sharpeners)
- 2 highlighters
- 3 dry erase markers
- Box of crayons, 24 or fewer
- Glue Sticks (at least six)
- Elmer's school liquid glue
- Clear contact paper to cover books

- 1 pack of colored pens (grades 5-8)
- Pair of quality pointed scissors (Fiskar-type recommended for students in grades 1-4)
- 3 Plastic pocket portfolios (any color)
- 2" Binder x 2 (grades 3 & up)
- 1" Binder x 1
- Index dividers for each binder (grades 3 & up)
- Spanish Dictionary (grades 6 and up)
- Geometry Set (Grades 7 & 8 only)
